Turning the off road vehicle in 4WD-LOCK ("DIFF LOCK") takes more effort.
Operate at a slow speed and allow extra time and distance for maneuvering, avoid loss of control.

Improper Use of Off-Highway Vehicles Can
This off-highway utility vehicle will handle and maneuver differently than a highway vehicle.
 • Vehicle capacity: 1 operator and 1 passenger. Passenger must be seated.
 • This vehicle is recommended only for operators 16 and older with proper supervision.
 • Gross Vehicle Weight Rating: 1940 lbs (880 kg); maximum including load.
 • Passenger and cargo can affect vehicle handling.
Be Sure Riders Pay Attention and Plan Ahead
 If you think or feel the vehicle may tip or roll, reduce your risk to injury:
 • Keep a firm grip on the steering wheel or handholds and brace yourself.
 • Do not put any part of your body outside of the vehicle for any reason.







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
